



How to see your teacher's feedback

1. Open Google Classroom and go to Classwork.




2. Click 'View your work'.



3. Here you will see all your assignments in a long list. You can see if they have a grade/score next to them. (This is usually out of 100 but might be different for quizzes and other tasks.)



On the left hand side, you can click to see your 'assigned' assignments that you need to complete, your 'returned with grade' assignments that your teacher has checked and returned to you and your 'missing' assignments that you have missed the due date for (but you can still complete them after this).

5. If you click on the title of the assignment, you can scroll down and see your teacher's private comments on that piece of work. You can type a message back to them by opening the file.
